SOLUTIONS-BASED JOURNALISM

Students identify a sustainability issue and focus their journalistic report on a solution that exists at the local level.

EDUCATIONAL TOOLS

We support teachers throughout the program, offer in-class workshops, and provide teachers and students with manuals tailored to different grade levels.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE

Through their journalistic investigations, students collaborate to build interdisciplinary knowledge

related to sustainability issues, while developing their critical and systems thinking skills.
