These projects combine scientific research, public awareness, and concrete action to protect biodiversity and preserve ecosystems.

### Main Objectives

1. **Protect natural habitats:** Promote the resilience of local ecosystems by restoring and maintaining habitats for diverse flora and fauna.
2. **Promote sustainable management:** Implement environmentally friendly methods while involving local communities.
3. **Raise awareness and provide training:** Educate the public about ecological issues through workshops, training sessions, and educational tours.

### Management and restoration actions

- [Domaine des Courmettes \(Alpes-Maritimes\)](#):
  - *Biodiversity conservation*: Studies on local flora and fauna, management of natural habitats (limestone areas, forests, meadows).
  - *Access for all*: Marked trails and outreach activities to explore ecology in a unique setting.
  - *Educational commitment*: Organization of programs and activities focused on climate and ecological issues.
- [Mas Mireille \(Vallée des Baux\)](#):
  - *Biodiversity conservation*: Contributing to the management of the Ilon Regional Nature Reserve, managing wetlands on private land, maintaining a network of birdhouses, planting hedges, etc.
  - *Scientific research*: Monitoring biodiversity and sharing data with scientific and local partners.
  - *Local initiatives*: Raising awareness among the public and local stakeholders through guided nature walks and special events.

## Methods used

- Ecological assessment to guide management.
- Partnerships with local and international organizations.
- Mobilization of volunteers and local groups to enhance the impact of actions.
