These workshops are led by Daniel, who guides us with passion and his valuable knowledge. Free and reserved for association members (remember to bring your boots and gloves)

Inclusion: Our association welcomes organizations working to support the inclusion of people with disabilities

For adults: The vegetable garden is tended by volunteers and members of the association. We pool our efforts and our harvests in a spirit of sharing, solidarity, and camaraderie!

We gather for workshops led by our permaculture facilitator on **Saturday** or **Sunday** afternoons to grow vegetables together between February and November.

For children: WEDNESDAYS IN THE GARDENS

Outdoor activities from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. every Wednesday (excluding school holidays). Registration is open on Helloasso: you can sign up by the quarter or for the entire year (September to July)

On the agenda: Gardening activities, nature observation, environmental awareness, cooking workshops...

For schools: We have developed “Nature and Heritage” days in collaboration with the Château de Voltaire. On the day’s program (10 a.m.–4 p.m.): Tour of the Château and a sensory tour of the Vegetable Garden. For children ages 3 to 12.
