The Champs-Élysées has been pedestrianized one Sunday a month since 2016. The number of "Paris Respire" zones is growing every year. The center of Paris is becoming more pedestrian-friendly. The cycling network is expanding. Streets are being pedestrianized in front of schools.

But there is still much to be done. We encourage the City to go much further with courage, speed, and determination so that private cars become the exception.
