La Tinette Stéphanoise is rethinking urban sanitation in Saint-Étienne.

This nonprofit promotes a growing network of dry toilets, offering an eco-friendly alternative to traditional water-intensive systems.

By increasing the number of collection points (voluntary drop-off) in the heart of the city, it simplifies logistics for residents eager to change their habits. The collected materials are then locally converted into agricultural compost.

This is a concrete circular economy initiative that transforms our waste into valuable resources while preserving drinking water.

"We try to support individuals, raise their awareness, and help them install dry toilets to replace water-flush toilets," she explains.
