Since 2017, Le Bateleur has organized “Solidarity Jars” food-processing events several times a year. The goal of this project is to establish a solidarity-based food supply chain in the Rhône-Alpes region through the creation of a range of products distributed to social and solidarity-based grocery stores in the Rhône-Alpes region, as well as to local food aid organizations.

To achieve this, Le Bateleur works in collaboration with producers who donate surplus or unsold goods. A partnership has been established with La [Passerelles des Vallées](#) – Espace de vie sociale for distribution, as well as with [the Accueillette](#) association, which organizes gleaning and redistribution. These two organizations participate in the collective, particularly through volunteering—from gleaning to processing and all the way through to redistribution!

Upholding its **ethics** at every stage of its work, **the team is committed** to producing these jars in service of a thriving local community. Le Bateleur has earned the [Nature & Progrès](#)

certification for its line of preserves, which commits the company to working exclusively **with organic products!**

Our jars are always available in St Pierreville, where the production facility is located; they are also available in many local stores... but you can also order them and have them delivered right to your door!
