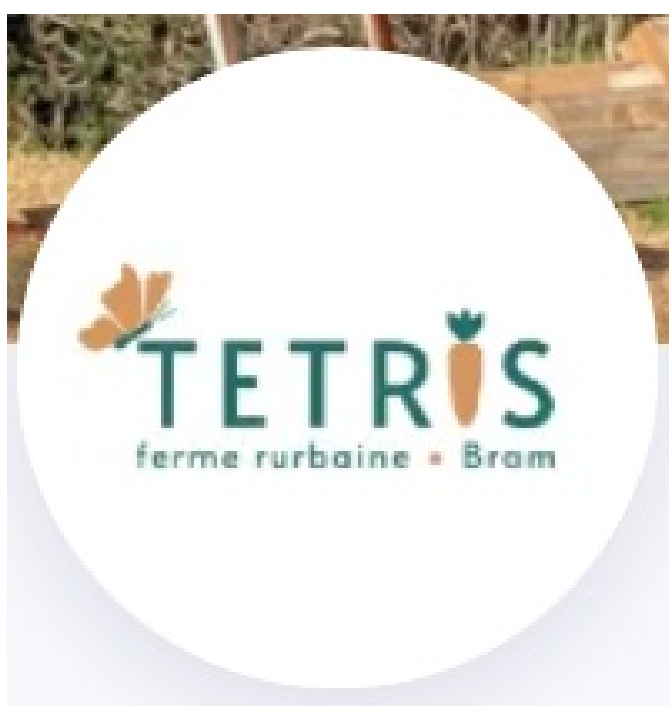

The goal is to create a space for experimentation and citizen engagement around an “urban-

rural” farm project in a rural setting, to enable the production of local products in shared gardens or even fields, and the processing and promotion of these products through the transfer of know-how.

This is a project that aims to raise awareness and support an agroecological transition and healthy, local food through a series of educational events and workshops for agriculture that is more respectful of how ecosystems function and nature’s cycles, and for a region that is more resilient to climate change.

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Global changes that require action in the face of these pressing issues make it imperative to rethink our relationship with the land and to promote more sustainable practices in land use planning and agriculture. Within the Occitanie region, a land of exceptional biological diversity, complex challenges related to environmental and climate change are emerging. Over the decades, urbanization has expanded, absorbing thousands of hectares of natural, agricultural, and forested land. In the face of these pressing issues, it is imperative to rethink our relationship with the land and to promote more sustainable practices in land use planning and agriculture.
