Citizen Science for Marine Biodiversity in the Gulf of Lion

The “Point Zero” project, initiated by the association “Les PEUPLES de la MER”: a human and wild adventure spanning 4 years, 160 missions, 12,000 km at sea, and over 50,000 observations.

The objective is to assess the initial state of marine biodiversity. This assessment focuses on a 150-km² area located in the Gulf of Lion Marine Nature Park, around the future Leucate floating wind farm. Our main objectives are to carry out initiatives on land and at sea to: ?

- raise awareness among everyone, and in particular among the residents of OCCITANIE and especially those of the Aude, Hérault, and Pyrénées-Orientales, about the wild marine species (cetaceans, turtles, sharks, large fish, birds) living nearby and at the heart of human activities,
- carry out annual projects to help restore a balance between human activities and the PEOPLE OF THE SEA,
- Promote the discovery of nature through a human-centered approach that respects all living things.
