IBP - POTENTIAL BIODIVERSITY INDEX

Difficulté : facile



The Potential Biodiversity Index (PBI) is a tool that enables forest managers to easily incorporate common taxonomic biodiversity into their day-to-day management practices.

This indicator, which is simple and quick to assess, makes it possible to **evaluate** a forest stand's **potential to support** living organisms (plants, birds, insects, etc.) and to **identify areas for improvement** during silvicultural operations.
