The Green Brigade's missions focus primarily on prevention, in coordination with key state agencies (police, gendarmerie, fire department, etc.) and other local institutions (Departmental Council, town halls, communities of municipalities, etc.).

Under the authority of the mayors, the Green Brigade's rural police officers primarily carry out the following duties:

- Monitoring forests and public roads.
- Monitoring hunting and fishing activities.
- Combating pollution, fires, noise, and various nuisances.
- Preventing construction without permits and violations of the Local Urban Planning Plan (PLU).

Enforcement and policing

duties They work in collaboration with the OFB (French Office for Biodiversity).

The Green Brigade serves as a point of contact for the “Beavers,” “Wolves,” and “Lynx” networks.

The Green Brigade also serves as a sentinel in the Haut-Rhin Department, in coordination with the Regional Health Agency, to detect the presence of ragweed.

Missions focused on information, education, and raising awareness about respecting natural

areas Information, awareness-raising, and education are among the Green Brigade’s core missions. Through outreach in schools or simply through daily interactions with visitors to natural areas, the Rural Rangers have the opportunity to remind people of the regulations in effect.

Diverse missions

- Preserving, managing, and caring for wildlife
- Combating illegal dumping
- Preventing pollution from unauthorized fires and other forms of pollution in natural areas
- Monitoring fishing and hunting activities
- Participating in environmental education for schoolchildren
- Protecting access to natural sites
