Our work focuses primarily on Africa, Asia, and Latin America, and we have an active presence in these regions.

GRAIN's role dates back to the early 1980s, when activists around the world began drawing attention to the dramatic loss of genetic diversity on our farms, which was eroding the very foundation of global food security.
