- URBAN VSOL: Integrating locally native wild plants into urban environments
- Assessing the relevance and effectiveness of implementing export mowing to reduce nutrient levels in soils
- Expanding knowledge of urban soil biodiversity and assessing associated ecosystem functions and services
- Understanding the dynamics of soil organisms (fauna, microorganisms) in relation to soil and environmental conditions (discontinuities in the green and brown infrastructure, climatic conditions, land uses, etc.)
- Measure the associated functional and/or taxonomic richness or diversity
